- (b) Write a Russian language article for your link school about young people and fashion. Say what you and your friends wear. Describe something you bought recently. Say whether you will buy clothes on the internet in the future and why.

- (c) Write a Russian blog about birthdays in the UK. Say how young people usually spend their birthday. Describe what you did for your birthday this year, whether you enjoyed it and what you will do for your next birthday and why.
